Summary - takeaways from the 2024 webinars

- Multimodal techniques leads to multi-sensory learning experience, which benefits all learners.
- Inclusive lessons are interactive, tactile and have opportunities for speaking, watching and listening.
- Storytelling with voices and props increases student engagement.
- Repetition in storytelling can be an effective technique to promote engagement and pronuniciation.
- Teaching and drilling functional language promotes student-centred communicative activities.

Summary

Benefits of Lesson Planning

- Defined stages and sequencing helps to achieve the learning aims.
- Planning and clear instructions can enable more student talk time
- Time management makes sure students get the most practice.
- Identifying potential problems in the planning stage prevents difficult classroom situations and lengthy explanations
