Practical exams are designed to test not only your knowledge of the subject but also your ability to perform under 'real life' conditions and how you cope if things do not go as expected. Please pay close attention to the briefing at the beginning of the exam to find out what to do if something goes wrong, e.g. if a test tube breaks or a piece of equipment malfunctions.

If you have any queries or feel that something happened that may affect the outcome of your exam, please see the exams duty officer at the venue who will be able to convey this information to the awarding body for consideration. It is vital that you do this on the day of the exam.
